Swiecki leads automotive and mobility research efforts in support of GEM as it enables the Detroit Region's existing mobility ecosystem to become better connected, smarter, more inclusive, and quickly adapt

to change. In addition to spearheading research to guide GEM's six regional projects, Swiecki will work with the entire industry supply chain from OEMs and suppliers to startups as they collectively adapt to rapid technology and industry changes.

Prior to joining the DRP, Swiecki served as the senior director of research and director of the Automotive Communities Partnership (ACP) at the Center for Automotive Research (CAR).
