Shannon Selby is Vice President of Real Estate for the Detroit Regional Partnership (DRP), a leading economic development nonprofit serving the 11-county Detroit Region. She leads the strategy, operations, and execution of the award-winning industrial site readiness program: Verified Industrial Properties (VIP by DRP). The program simplifies the site selection process and provides corporate decision makers with an easily accessible online inventory of vacant industrial properties vetted by third-party civil engineers. It maintains the necessary inventory to compete for and win new projects that bring jobs and investment to the Detroit Region.

Selby was hired at the inception of VIP by DRP and has advanced the site readiness program from nine pilot sites and a \$500,000 budget to a \$17-million program with now 90 sites — with plans to scale to 120. In this role, Selby negotiates multi-million-dollar contracts and leads the DRP's real estate team as well as 10 consulting teams that provide civil and environmental engineering, strategy and site identification, and marketing services to the program. Last year alone Selby deployed \$4M towards on the ground physical site studies including wetland delineation, Geotech, Alta survey, Phase I and others studies to 38 VIP Sites. Selby regularly speaks nationally and locally at conferences and industrial summits. She collaborates with the Michigan Economic Development Corporation on industrial site readiness and corporate attraction. Selby also leads the VIP by DRP Advisory Council consisting of 16 CRE professionals, including national and international site consultants, real estate developers, utility partners, and brokers.

A licensed real estate broker in Michigan and Arizona, Selby is an accomplished real estate, economic and community development leader with a proven track record with experience that spans city, county, and regional levels in both private and public sectors. Selby spearheaded multimillion dollar signature real estate developments in both a real estate broker capacity and as an economic developer. Selby's 18-year tenure has resulted in over 300 company relocations, 18,000 jobs, and \$5 billion in capital investment.
