# Astemo Deepens its Investment in the Detroit Region

Astemo's next chapter in Michigan builds on a presence the global automotive supplier has established over years in the state. The company's new regional headquarters and technical center in Wixom brings together business units, engineering teams and R&D capabilities in one campus, creating greater opportunities for collaboration and innovation.

The \$95 million investment in Oakland County includes commitments to at least 200 new jobs, more than 150 of them in engineering. The project expands Astemo's footprint in the Detroit Region while keeping key North American operations close to the automotive customers, talent and industry expertise that support its business.

## STRENGTHENING A GLOBAL RELATIONSHIP

Supporting Astemo's continued investment in Michigan was a collaborative effort that extended from the Detroit Region to the company's global headquarters in Japan. DRP worked alongside the Michigan Economic Development Corporation and Oakland County to engage Astemo leadership and reinforce the value of expanding its presence in the region.

Together, the partners met with company leadership at Astemo's corporate headquarters in Japan, presenting a coordinated case for Michigan and demonstrating the state and region's commitment to the company's continued growth. That engagement helped support the broader effort that ultimately brought Astemo's new regional headquarters and technical center to Wixom.



## SUPPORTING THE WIXOM INVESTMENT

As plans for the new campus moved forward, DRP brought additional resources to the project through its Verified Industrial Properties (VIP) program. VIP End User Support funding provided direct assistance tied to advancing the investment, complementing the broader state and local support behind the project. Astemo received local tax abatements and industrial and commercial facility tax credits through the City of Wixom, as well as a \$2 million performance-based Michigan Business Development Program grant.

## A NEW CENTER FOR ENGINEERING AND INNOVATION

The Wixom campus brings Astemo's regional headquarters and technical center functions together in a location designed to support engineering, research and development, testing and collaboration across its automotive business units.

The project includes 185,000 square feet of office and laboratory space, along with expanded testing capabilities. With more than 150 engineering positions included among the project's job commitments, the investment adds high-value technical opportunities while further anchoring Astemo's North American engineering and R&D presence in the Detroit Region.

For the region, Astemo's investment represents more than an expanded corporate footprint. It strengthens the concentration of global automotive engineering, innovation and decision-making that continues to distinguish the Detroit Region.
